### NATURE NAVIGATORS SUMMER DAY CAMP RECAP

> Fauquier County 4-H and John Marshall Soil & Water Conservation District's 2025 Nature Navigators camp is officially wrapped up! We packed the week with hands-on learning about watersheds, wildlife, stream monitoring, chemical reactions, the environment and more! Here is a quick recap:

> On Monday, we learned about watersheds and how to protect our natural resources. We then investigated the diets of the barn owl with owl pellet dissections. The day wrapped up with games to learn about how pollinators pollinate our plants and how bats feed on insects!

On Tuesday, we spent our day at the <u>Fauquier Education Farm</u> and in Turkey Run. We learned how to collect stream data with biological, physical and chemical monitoring by taking measurements and collecting (and releasing) macroinvertebrates! We wrapped up the

day with a discussion with Fauquier Education Farm's Executive Director, Jim, about where our food comes from!

On Wednesday, we traveled to the Fauquier Outdoor Lab to learn about the physical and behavioral adaptations of wildlife, study chemical reactions with cyanotyping, and explore our environment with a nature hike!

On Thursday, we wrapped up the week with hands-on activities provided by Oak Spring Garden Foundation to teach about the natural dyes found in plants, and then learned about some adaptations and migration patterns of birds with games and more art!

### **CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR 2025 CARCASS AWARD WINNERS!**



The Fauquier Livestock Show & Sale is a terminal project - meaning these animals are raised specifically for meat. All market animals go through an ultrasound process to get data on their carcass merit, including traits such as Back Fat thickness, Rib Eye Area, Loin Eye Area, and others. Animals are ranked on these traits and their grading score according to the current market.

The Rate of Gain contest is based on the average daily gain of market animals during their growing season (180 days for beef; 90 days for sheep and goats). Check out the gains made by our 2025 Show & Sale animals!
