



LAMB & GOAT WEIGH-IN RECAP

On the chilly morning of February 2nd, Fauquier Livestock Show & Sale weighed in 41 market lamb and 7 market goat projects for 32 lamb/goat exhibitors! The youth committee worked together to line up trucks and trailers, collect entries, man scale gates, tag animals, record weights, and more! Market lambs and goats are weighed-in the first weekend in February, then again in May the weekend of Show & Sale. Exhibitors grow their animals for 90 project days to compete for Rate of Gain - a contest to see whose animal gains the most pounds each day!

TREE HIGHLIGHTS

For February I am highlighting a sycamore tree at Warrenton Cemetery. Cemeteries are often a great place to find old community trees. Take a look around and let me know if you find a noteworthy community tree in your neighborhood at tohlwile@vt.edu

Tree: American Sycamore - Platanus occidentalis

Location: Warrenton Cemetery, enter the cemetery on Chestnut Street, the sycamore is the second large tree on your left.

Age: This is a native tree that is difficult to tell the age. It may have sprouted up, or it may have been planted. Graves in the area date to the early 1900s.

Size: The canopy spreads over 100 ft. wide and is estimated to be over100 ft. tall.

The diameter of the trunk is over 4 ft.

I love the bright, almost white, bark on the branches of sycamore. The light-colored bark is revealed when the older bark flakes off. These native trees often grow in bottomland next to streams and rivers.

This is nowhere near the largest sycamore in the state. This Virginia Big Trees website has several larger sycamore trees. Visit https://bigtree.cnre.vt.edu/index.html or scan the QR code below! Can you find any trees from Fauquier County on this website?
