#### THE ELEANOR HAZEL 4-H AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM RECAPI

Last month The Eleanor Hazel 4-H After School Program wrapped up their Series 3: Wacky Gadgets!

3rd - 5th grade students learned about simple circuits and machines. Participants participated in fun activities including making paper circuit lanterns, an art and throwing arm robot, squishy circuit, a hydraulic claw, making game controllers out of conductive materials and so much more!

Key concepts covered:

- Electrical Circuits (open vs closed)
  - Series Circuit
  - Parallel Circuit
    - Conductors
      - Insulators
    - Hydraulics

#### 2025 SPRING BREAK 4-H CAMP RECAP!

#### On Monday:

Participants learned about the various parts of plants that we eat and some kids even discovered new vegetables they liked! Later we learned about and dissected owl pellets! We also played some outdoor games to get all those wiggles out!

#### On Tuesday:

Participants made their own balloon cars and catapults. We learned about concepts including stored energy, trajectory, and thrust. Campers also participated in various team building activities and games.

#### On Wednesday:

Participants learned about simple circuits and batteries. We made batteries out of various produce items such as apples, potatoes, lemons, and bananas. We also built light and fan circuits using Play-Doh and Modeling Clay and discussed conductor vs insulators. We also learned about the physical reaction of nucleation through Mentos and Soda geysers! Things got a little extra exciting when the bottle tipped over!



#### On Thursday:

Fauquier County 4-H had the pleasure of hosting our friends from Oak Spring Garden Foundation who taught campers about Natural Dyes! Students had fun learning about various plants and the colors they can create with them. Participants dyed handkerchiefs with Indigo, created ornaments using lobster mushroom dyed felt, extracted water color paint and planted seeds from marigolds, and learned about how changing pH levels can affect various plant dyes.

#### TREE HIGHLIGHTS

For May I am highlighting a Red Buckeye tree at Rady Park. If you have a tree you would like me to highlight, please send a note to <a href="mailto:tohlwile@vt.edu">tohlwile@vt.edu</a>

Rady Park Arboretum is a collection of trees and shrubs located along the northwest boundary of the Park with neighboring Fenton Farm. The arboretum was begun in 1999 to highlight trees and shrubs that are suitable for local gardens but may be underutilized.

Tree: Red Buckeye - Aesculus pavia

**Location:** Rady Park Arboretum, enter the Park from Fauquier Road and park in the parking lot. Cross the stream at the first bridge, the one closest to Highway 17. The red buckeye will be in bloom about the time this newsletter comes out and it will be back along the board fence with the farm.

**Age:** This is a native tree that was planted in 2012.

**Size:** The canopy spreads over 15 ft. wide and about the same height. This tree had its top branches broken out when a dead ash tree was being taken down. It was near the red buckeye and branches that were cut off the ash tree fell and broke down the top of the red buckeye in 2018.

The small native tree has spikes of red flowers in mid spring. They will eventually mature and produce large nuts.


