

4-H GOODS FROM THE WOODS

We are so grateful for the Fauquier & Rappahannock County Master Gardeners who facilitate our Goods from the Woods program! Students will learn how to plant a tree, what Oriented Strand Board (OSB) is, and the process of a tree's life. Volunteers have packaged tree seedlings and learning kits for 17 schools, including 46 classrooms in Fauquier County, serving over 1,000 students K-12! Most students will be able to take home a tree seedling of their own to plant. What better way to kick off the first few weeks of spring?!

The Fauquier 4-H Livestock Judging Teams competed at the Virginia State Skillathon Wednesday March 27th at the Rockingham County Fairgrounds. Participants identify livestock feeds, breeds, equipment, meats, and judge live animals, meats, and hay. They also work together on a production based team problem, individual quiz, and quality assurance activity. After the contest, all participants, coaches, and parents were invited to hear Dr. Temple Grandin speak about her life experiences working with animal behavior and visual thinking.
