#### ELEANOR HAZEL 4-H AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAM UPDATE



The Eleanor Hazel 4-H After School Program wrapped up Series 3: Wacky Gadgets earlier this month. Students learned basic electronics and mechanical principles by making squishy circuits, paper circuits, a hydraulic claw machine, a mechanical throwing arm, a banana piano and using cutting edge technology such as Ozobots, Makey Makey and LittleBits! It has been so fun watching students' creativity, teamwork, and excitement as they developed life skills like collaboration, communication, and critical thinking.

#### READY... SET... GROW!

Ready, Set, Grow! is a 4-H program facilitated by the Fauquier & Rappahannock County Master Gardeners. First grade students learn how to plant seeds, what 'visitors' a garden might have (animals, insects, etc.), and even get to touch and feel different garden elements, such as branches, herbs, snake skins, or turtle shells! Volunteers prepared for this program by packaging learning kits for 12 schools, serving over 1,000 Fauquier County students!


